I hereby certify that on the 12th day of [REDACTED], beginning at 10:00 hours, I, Marc A. Krouse, M.D., pursuant to Statute 49.25 of Texas Criminal Code, made an inquest on the body of [REDACTED] **Almodova** at the Tarrant County Medical Examiner's District Morgue in Fort Worth, Texas and upon investigation of the essential facts concerning the circumstances of the death and history of the case as known to me, I am of the opinion that the findings, cause and manner of death are as follows:

FINDINGS:

- I) External evidence of blunt force traumatic injuries of head, face, and extremities
- II) Ecchymosis of posterior neck and upper back; clinical history of T2-3 fracture and distraction

GROSS ANATOMIC DESCRIPTION

I. CLOTHING AND PERSONAL EFFECTS: At the time of examination, the body is nude.

II. THERAPEUTIC INTERVENTION: Evidence of medical intervention includes a right nasogastric tube, intravenous lines on the dorsal right hand, in the right femoral triangle, and in the right subclavian fossa, bilateral chest tubes, four electrocardiographic monitor pads, a cervical collar, oral airway, splint on the left wrist, pulse oximeter on the left second finger, a stapled peritoneal lavage site, and a Foley catheter with attached drain containing 1300 mL of urine.

III. EXTERNAL BODY DESCRIPTION: The body is that of a normally developed, well nourished and well hydrated, elderly Latin American male appearing near the stated age of 66 years. The body length is 75 inches and the weight is 249.4 pounds (190 cm, 113.1 kg). The body is relatively well-preserved, unembalmed, and cool post refrigeration. Rigor is fully developed. Lividity is developed, dependent over the back, purple and slightly blanchable.

The scalp is covered by short straight gray hair with 10 cm frontal and sagittal pattern baldness. A gray mustache is present; the face is otherwise shaved. Body hair is male distribution and average.

The calvarium is symmetric and intact by palpation and the scalp is intact except for a laceration and abrasion of the mid occipital area. The eyes are closed and the corneas are slightly clouded. There is no conjunctival hemorrhage. The irides are brown and the pupils are 7 mm. There is ecchymosis over the medial right orbit and entire left orbit, both upper and lower lids. Yellow-colored fluid is found in the nasal and oral cavities. The lips and oral mucosa are pale. The dentition is natural and well maintained. There is a vague ecchymosis over the posterior neck; the neck, larynx, and hyoid are grossly intact by palpation and facial bones are intact.

The anterior chest is symmetric and intact by palpation. There are bilateral chest tubes. The abdomen is slightly protuberant. There is a sutured peritoneal lavage site. There are a number of scars on the abdomen with an inverted V-shaped

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scar meeting in the midline (15 cm left limb, 28 cm right limb) with a vertical 5 x 1 cm scar extending upward to the epigastrium. There is a vertical, 12 x 2 cm scar on the right abdomen, vertically oriented and lying slightly right of midline. The pelvis is intact by palpation. The penis is uncircumcised and the testes are descended. The perineum and anal orifice are unremarkable. The back is symmetric and intact. There is a 12 cm midline lumbar scar.

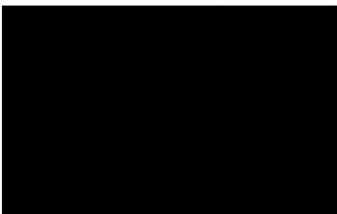
Extremities are symmetric, normally developed, and are intact. Injuries are described below. The nails of the hands and feet are pale. An obscure design is tattooed on the volar left forearm.

IV. EVIDENCE OF INJURY: There are external injuries of the head and face, evidence of spinal trauma, and injuries of the left arm and right leg:

- 1) Vertically oriented 5 x 1.5 cm abrasion with central 5 mm laceration, mid occipital scalp
- 2) Vague ecchymosis of posterior neck extending onto posterior upper back (clinical history of T2-3 fracture and distraction)
- 3) Sutured 4 cm laceration extending laterally from lateral left brow ridge with orbital ecchymosis
- 4) Bilateral chest tubes
- 5) Peritoneal lavage site
- 6) Abrasions up to 2 mm diameter, dorsal left forearm, wrist, and hand
- 7) 6 x 2.5 cm abrasion, mid anterior right tibia

SPFCIMENS AND EVIDENCE COLLECTED

1. 5 mL of femoral venous blood, 30 mL of urine, and 5 mL of vitreous humor for storage
